'Compete with heart, win with pride'



In its entirety, the celebration was a perfect blend of fun, learning, and inspiration, making it a memorable day for both the students and the teachers.






The event concluded with expressions of gratitude and a shared sense of joy embodying love, unity, and celebration. It was truly a reflection of the school's spirit and togetherness.









A busy town it was. I noticed people weren't paying for what they bought. Every single living soul behaved kindly with the other. None got angry. None argued.




मेरी पसंदीदा याद


Celebrating the Legacy of Our Retiring Educators
